

RTA and Citi Bank Group sign agreement

Public Transport Agency at the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) signed an MoU with Citi Bank Group at Muhaisna 4 yesterday.

The agreement calls for the Public Transport Agency to act as a consultant in assisting Citi Group with the introduction of a host of mass transit programmes, where the group will allocate buses to transport its employees from and to their residents.
