The office also boasts four unique outdoor terraces – a Working Terrace, Garden Terrace, Relax Terrace, and Client Terrace – providing employees with fresh air, opportunities for well-being, and informal gathering spaces. Inclusive new spaces such as a fitness room, respite lounge, family/lactation room, and enhanced bicycle facilities further demonstrate Citi's dedication to creating a supportive and balanced work environment.
